About Heritage & Science Park:

Heritage & Science Park is a striking reminder of the city's vibrant Victorian past. Located on Block 14 of the original townsite of Phoenix, the area dates back to the late 1800s, and the restored Rosson House Museum is its crowning jewel. The park is operated in conjunction by The Square PHX (a 501c-3 non-profit organization) and the City of Phoenix Parks & Recreation Department, and is owned by the City of Phoenix.

About Rosson House Museum:

The Rosson House Museum is a fully restored 1895 Queen Anne Victorian house museum, interpreting the history of Phoenix and Territorial Arizona. Tours of the house include all living areas and offer visitors a glimpse into the lifestyles of early Phoenix families. Admission to the Rosson House Museum is by guided tour only. All tours last approximately 60 minutes.
