Background Information:

History: The Teeter House Restoration Project involved the renovation of the Teeter House, The Teeter Carriage House, and the Steven Haustgen House within Heritage Square. All three buildings were built around the turn of the 20th century and have played a part in Arizona's early history. This restoration project, which began in 1979, has led to a revitalization of Heritage Square and has allowed local businesses as well as the area's history to flourish since its completion in 1980.

Scope and Content and Arrangement:

Scope and Content: The records of the Teeter House Restoration Project include correspondence, newspaper clippings, building plans, and photographs. The strength of the collection is found with the photographs, building plans, and newspaper clippings. These items give a historical overview of the renovation project of Phoenix's oldest square.

The Manual Covers folder contains manual covers regarding the restoration of the Teeter House.

The *Newspaper Clippings* folder contains articles on regarding the restoration project and its importance, filed by date.
